OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH & SOCIAL SERVICES

The attached 3 pages of regulations, dealing with the child care assistance program, related to the program rates, enrollment authorization, family contribution toward care, and continued participation, are adopted and certified to be a correct copy of the regulation changes that the Department of Health & Social Services adopts under the authority of AS 47.05.010, AS 47.25.001, AS 47.25.041, and AS 47.25.051, and after compliance with the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62), specifically including notice under AS 44.62.190 and 44.62.200 and opportunity for public comment under AS 44.62.210.

The regulation changes adopted under this order take effect on the 30th day after they have been filed by the lieutenant governor, as provided in AS 44.62.180.





We have reviewed the attached regulations from the Department of Health and Social Services against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. I have reviewed this project under a specific delegation dated August 4, 2017 from the Regulations Attorney. The regulations make follow-up refinements to procedures and requirements for the child care assistance program--recently amended on an omnibus level, with those amendments having taken effect on January 5, 2017 (Department of Law file number 2016200208)--in particular addressing rates, enrollment authorizations, the family contribution towards care, and continued participation.

We find no legal problems. This memorandum constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations.

The April 19, 2017 public notice and the June 29, 2017 adoption order both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.195 is not required.

The Department of Health & Social Services proposes to change regulations on the child care assistance program related to the program rates, enrollment authorization, family contribution toward care, and continued participation.

The Department of Health & Social Services proposes to adopt regulation changes in Title 7 of the Alaska Administrative Code, dealing with the child care assistance program, including the following:

- 7 AAC 41.025. Program Rates- is proposed to be changed as follows: Revise rates to the Child Care Assistance Program Rate Schedule for the maximum state payment to a child care provider.
- 7 AAC 41.035. Enrollment authorization- is proposed to be changed as follows: Allow for a child in a shared custody arrangement to be authorized for up to a maximum of a full month enrollment for each parent based on service delivery area.
- 7 AAC 41.335. Family income and contribution schedule- is proposed to be changed as follows:
 - Revise the 2008 Family Income and Contribution Schedule for participating families to pay the provider a percentage of their income.
 - Revise the Family Income and Contribution Schedule to expand the maximum allowable income.
- 7 AAC 41.335(d) is proposed to be repealed.
 - The intended effect of this repeal is to allow participating families to continue participating in the program without requiring a phase-out period.
