3 AAC 190.460(4)

In accordance with the authority of the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the correction to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. I have forwarded this correction under a specific delegation dated December 1, 2015 from the regulations attorney. This revision corrects a manifest error in a reference to a law.

The regulation to be revised is 3 AAC 190.460(4). The revision to that paragraph is as follows:

--Change "3 AAC 190.900" to "3 AAC 190.990"

In addition, please insert an editor's note after 3 AAC 190.460 to read:

Editor's note: As of Register 224 (January 2018), the regulations attorney made a technical correction under AS 44.62.125(b)(6), to 3 AAC 190.460.

This edit is necessary because in 3 AAC 190 the section defining "bona fide village resident" is 3 AAC 190.990, not 3 AAC 190.900. A section numbered 3 AAC 190.900 does not exist presently. Thank you for your assistance, and please contact me if you have additional questions.
