3 AAC 306.700 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

(f) The board may not issue a marijuana handler permit to a person that

(1) has been convicted of a felony in the state and either

(A) less than five years have elapsed from the time of the person's

conviction; or

(B) the person is currently on probation or parole for that felony.

(2) has within two years, before submitting an application, been convicted of a class A misdemeanor crime in the state involving a controlled substance other than a Schedule VI controlled substance.

(3) has within two years, before submitting an application, been convicted of a class A misdemeanor in the state relating to selling, furnishing, or distributing marijuana; or,

(4) is currently under indictment for an offense listed in this section that would prevent qualification for a permit. (Eff.)__/_/____, Register____)

3 AAC 306.8xx Suspension or revocation of marijuana handler permit. (a) The board may suspend or revoke a permit issued under this chapter, refuse to renew a permit, or impose a civil fine if the board finds that a permit holder is found to act in violation of this chapter. (Eff. __/__/____, Register____)
