SUBJECT: Corrections to the Alaska
Administrative Code (AAC):
3 AAC 304.650(l)(2)

In accordance with the authority of the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the correction to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. I have forwarded this correction under a specific delegation dated December 1, 2015 from the regulations attorney. This revision is a conforming change to reflect the rearrangement of paragraphs in AS 04.21.080 by the revisor of statutes.

The regulation to be revised is 3 AAC 304.650(l)(2) (definition of "drunken person"). The revision to that paragraph is as follows:

--Change "AS 04.21.080(b)(8)" to "AS 04.21.080(b)"

--At the end of the existing editor's note that follows 3 AAC 304.650, add a new paragraph to read as follows:

In 2016 the revisor of statutes--acting under AS 01.05.031 and codifying changes that appear in sec. 12, ch. 32, SLA 2016--realphabetized definitions in AS 04.21.080(b), so that a definition originally numbered AS 04.21.080(b)(8) is now numbered AS 04.21.080(b)(9). As of Register 224 (January 2018), the regulations attorney made a conforming technical revision under AS 44.62.125(b)(6), to 3 AAC 304.650(l), so that a cross-reference to former AS 04.21.080(b)(8) now refers simply to AS 04.21.080(b).
