OF THE BOARD OF VETERINARY EXAMINERS


The attached two pages of regulations, dealing with licensing and application requirements for veterinarians and veterinary technicians, are hereby certified to be a correct copy of the regulation changes that the Board of Veterinary Examiners adopted at its October 20, 2017 teleconference meeting, under the authority of AS 08.01.062, AS 08.98.050, AS 08.98.080, AS 08.98.165, AS 08.98.167, and AS 08.98.184 and after compliance with the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62), specifically including notice under AS 44.62.190 and 44.62.200 and opportunity for public comment under AS 44.62.210.

This action is not expected to require an increased appropriation.

Although no public comments were received, the Board of Veterinary Examiners paid special attention to the cost to private persons of the regulatory action being taken.


The regulation changes described in this order take effect on the 30th day after they have been filed by the lieutenant governor, as provided in AS 44.62.180.
