ORDER ADOPTING CHANGES TO REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE. COMMUNITY, AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Chapter 02. General Occupational Licensing Functions.

12 AAC 02 is amended by adding a new section to read:

prescription database registration. The following fees are established for registration with the prescription database by a pharmacist who dispenses, or a practitioner who prescribes, administers, or directly

dispenses a schedule II, III, or IV controlled substance under federal law as required under AS 17.30.200?

- (1) initial registration fee, \$25;
- (2) biennial registration renewal fee, \$25. (Eff. 4/22 / 2018, Register 226)
