**SUBJECT:** Corrections to the Alaska  
Administrative Code (AAC):  
12 AAC 44.966(h)(2)

In accordance with the authority of the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the corrections to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. I have forwarded these corrections under a specific delegation dated December 1, 2015 from the regulations attorney. These revisions correct manifest errors.

The regulation to be revised is 12 AAC 44.966(h)(2), the definition of "immediately available on site". The revisions to this paragraph are as follows:

--Change "advanced nurse practitioner" and "nurse practitioner" to "advanced practice registered nurse"

In addition, in the editor's note that follows 12 AAC 44.966, please add a new paragraph at the end to read:

As of Register 226 (July 2018), the regulations attorney made technical revisions, under AS 44.62.125(b)(6), to 12 AAC 44.966(h).

These edits are conforming changes, to reflect the Board of Nursing's amendments elsewhere in 12 AAC 44 to replace "advanced nurse practitioner" with "advanced practice registered nurse": part of regulations changes that the lieutenant governor's office filed on April 16, 2018 with an effective date of May 16, 2018 (Department of Law file number JU2017200464 (Part 1)).
