ORDER CERTIFYING THE CHANGES TO REGULATIONS OF THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL BOARD

The attached two pages of regulations, dealing with fee changes for new licenses, relocations, transfers and renewals of existing licenses, and allowing a seasonal alternating premises designation, are certified to be a correct copy of the regulation changes that the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board adopted at its January 23, 2018, meeting, under the authority of AS 04.06.100 and after compliance with the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62), specifically including notice under AS 44.62.190 and 44.62.200 and opportunity for public comment under AS 44.62.210.

This action is not expected to require an increased appropriation.

Although no public comments were received, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board paid special attention to the cost to private persons of the regulatory action being taken.

The regulation changes described in this order take effect on July 1, 2018, as provided in AS 44.62.180.

3 AAC 304.185 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

- (e) A licensee may request to have a portion of its licensed premises alternate as licensed or unlicensed premises on a seasonal basis under the following conditions:
- (1) the request is made on a form prescribed by the board, accompanied by a detailed premises diagram and \$250 fee;
- (2) a debt that is incurred during times when the identified area is unlicensed will be considered a debt incurred in the operation of the licensed business for purposes of transfer of the license under AS 04.11.360;
- (3) at any time with written notice to the licensee, the board may withdraw its approval of use of the identified area as alternating premises;
- (4) during times the identified area is designated as an unlicensed premises, all alcoholic beverages must either be removed from the identified area or be stored in a location approved by the board to be secure from the public.
