SUBJECT: Corrections to the Alaska  
Administrative Code (AAC):  
18 AAC 70.990(25)

In accordance with the authority of the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the corrections to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. I have forwarded these corrections under a specific delegation dated December 1, 2015 from the regulations attorney. These revisions correct manifest errors.

The regulation to be revised is 18 AAC 70.990(25), the definition of "fecal coliform bacteria" as it appears in the printed, hard-copy version of the Alaska Administrative Code. The manifest errors do *not* appear in the publisher's electronic database. The revision to that paragraph is as follows:

--After each appearance of the mathematical "plus or minus" sign ("±"), delete the small dash ("-") that appears immediately afterwards.

In addition, at the end of the editor's note that follows 18 AAC 70.990, add a new paragraph to read as follows:

--As of Register 226 (July 2018), the regulations attorney made technical corrections under AS 44.62.125(b)(6), to the definition of "fecal coliform bacteria" in 18 AAC 70.990.
