SUBJECT: Correction to the Alaska
Administrative Code (AAC):
18 AAC 75.849(5)(B)

In accordance with the authority of the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the correction to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. I have forwarded this correction under a specific delegation dated December 1, 2015 from the regulations attorney. This revision corrects a manifest error.

The regulation to be revised is 18 AAC 75.849(5)(B), part of the definition of "permanently closed". The revision to that subparagraph is as follows:

--After "AST" and before the semicolon, insert "and blanked off"

In addition, after 18 AAC 75.849, please insert an editor's note to read as follows:

Editor's note: As of Register 226 (July 2018), the regulations attorney made a technical correction under AS 44.62.125(b)(6), to the definition of "permanently closed" in 18 AAC 75.849.
