BRIEF DESCRIPTION: The Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development proposes to change occupational license fees charged to social workers.

The Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development (Department) proposes to adopt regulation changes in Title 12, Chapter 02 of the Alaska Administrative Code including the following:

**12 AAC 02.155. Board of Social Work Examiners,** is proposed to be changed to amend the license, renewal, and continuing education course submittal and resubmittal fees for social workers.

Under AS 08.01.065, the Department must establish fee levels so that the total amount of fees collected for an occupation approximately equals the actual regulatory costs for the occupation. The Department has reviewed the income and expenses for the occupational licensing program for the Board of Social Work Examiners and proposes fee changes that reflect, to the extent possible, the actual costs of the activities related to the program.
