## NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES ON PREMISES DIAGRAMS AND NONCONTIGUOUS PREMISES IN THE REGULATIONS OF THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL BOARD

The State of Alaska Alcoholic Beverage Control Board proposes to adopt regulation changes in 3 AAC 304 of the Alaska Administrative Code, dealing with licensed premises, including the following:

- 3 AAC 304.185 is proposed to allow noncontiguous licensed premises for destination resort licenses and recreation site licenses.
- 3 AAC 304.225 is proposed add beverage dispensary licenses to the list of license types that can have areas of the premises that may alternate between licensed and unlicensed under specific conditions.

You may comment on the proposed regulation changes, including the potential costs to private persons of complying with the proposed changes, by submitting written comments to the Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office at 550 West 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Suite 1600, Anchorage, AK 99501. The comments must be received not later than 4:30 pm on Friday, June 1, 2018.

The questions must be received at least 10 days before the end of the public comment period. The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board will aggregate its response to substantially similar questions and make the questions and responses available on the Alaska Online Public Notice System and AMCO Website.
