7 AAC 10.990(14), (22)

In accordance with the authority of the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the corrections to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. I have forwarded these corrections under a specific delegation dated December 1, 2015 from the regulations attorney. These revisions correct manifest errors.

The regulations to be revised are 7 AAC 10.990(14) and (22). The revisions to those paragraphs are as follows:

--At the end of 7 AAC 10.990(14), insert a semicolon

--In 7 AAC 10.990(22), change the term being defined from "overnight division" to "oversight division"

Regarding 7 AAC 10.990(22), I compared what appears in print in the Alaska Administrative Code to what your office transmitted to the publisher, and I confirmed that a printing error occurred.
