Administrative Code (AAC):

20 AAC 10.020(d)(1), (2);

20 AAC 10.900(4)

In accordance with the authority of the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the corrections to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. I have forwarded these corrections under a specific delegation dated December 1, 2015 from the regulations attorney. These revisions correct manifest errors, including a manifest error in a reference to a law.

The regulations to be revised are 20 AAC 10.020(d)(1) and (2) and 20 AAC 10.900(4). The revisions to those provisions are as follows:

--In 20 AAC 10.020(d)(1), change "any may not discriminate" to "and may not discriminate"

--In 20 AAC 10.020(d)(2), change "AS 14.20.270" to "AS 14.20.370"

--In 20 AAC 10.900(4)(A), change "certified educator" to "a certified educator;", i.e., insert the indefinite article "a" and insert a semicolon at the end of this subparagraph

In particular, regarding the correction to 20 AAC 10.020(d)(2), I compared how that provision appears in print in the April 2018 quarterly supplement (Register 225) with that text as filed on August 28, 2017 with an effective date of September 27, 2017 and as transmitted to the publisher; and I have confirmed that the reference to AS 14.20.270 rather than AS 14.20.370 was a typographical error by the publisher. The citation instead should read "AS 14.20.370".
