SUBJECT: Corrections to the Alaska
Administrative Code (AAC):
7 AAC 125

In accordance with the authority of the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the corrections to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. I have forwarded these corrections under a specific delegation dated December 1, 2015 from the regulations attorney. These revisions correct manifest errors.

The regulations to be revised are various provisions of 7 AAC 125. The revisions to those provisions are as follows:

--In 7 AAC 125.040(a)(13), change "performance or that activity" to "performance of that activity"

--In 7 AAC 125.050(a)(1)(B), change "wasted disposal" to "waste disposal"

--In the second clause of 7 AAC 125.080(c)(4), change "connective action plan" to "corrective action plan"

--In 7 AAC 125.110(b)(1)(B), change "welfare or the recipient" to "welfare of the recipient"

--In 7 AAC 125.199(1) (the definition of "ADL"), change "activities" to "activity"

I compared what appears in print in the Alaska Administrative Code to what your office transmitted to the publisher--regulations filed June 22, 2017, and effective July 22, 2017 (Register 223 (October 2017))--and I confirmed that printing errors occurred.
