ORDER ADOPTING CHANGES TO REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, COMMUNITY, AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations by the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This memorandum constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations concern occupational licensing fees for registered, practical and advance practice registered nurses. The client agency requests that these regulations be filed in time to be effective by August 1, 2018, or sooner in time to be effective for the upcoming license renewal in September.

The May 17, 2018 public notice and the June 25, 2018 adoption order both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.195 is not required.

We have made a minor technical correction as shown on the attached copy of the regulations.

NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES TO OCCUPATIONAL LICENSING FEES FOR PROFESSIONS REGULATED BY THE BOARD OF NURSING IN THE REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, COMMUNITY, AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

BRIEF DESCRIPTION: The Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development proposes to change occupational license fees charged to registered or practical nurses, advanced practice registered nurses, and certified nurse aides.

The Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development (Department) proposes to adopt regulation changes in Title 12, Chapter 02 of the Alaska Administrative Code including the following:

- 1. 12 AAC 02.280. Board of Nursing: fees for nurses and advanced practice registered nurses, is proposed to be changed to amend the application, license, renewal, temporary permit, prescriptive authority or controlled substance authority, retired nurse license, and fingerprint processing fees for registered or practical nurses (RN/PN) and advanced practice registered nurses (APRN).
- 2. 12 AAC 02.282. Board of Nursing: fees for certified nurse aides, is proposed to be changed to amend the application, examination, reexamination, and fingerprint processing fees for certified nurse aides (CNA).

Under AS 08.01.065, the Department must establish fee levels so that the total amount of fees collected for an occupation approximately equals the actual regulatory costs for the occupation. The Department has reviewed the income and expenses for the occupational licensing program for the Board of Nursing and proposes fee changes that reflect, to the extent possible, the actual costs of the activities related to the program.

You may comment on the proposed regulation changes, including the potential costs to private persons of complying with the proposed changes, by submitting written comments to Jun Maiquis, Regulations Specialist, Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing, P.O. Box 110806, Juneau, AK 99811-0806. Additionally, the Department will accept comments by facsimile at (907) 465-2974 and by electronic mail at RegulationsAndPublicComment@alaska.gov. The comments must be received not later than 5:00 p.m. on June 18, 2018. Comments received after this deadline will not be considered by the Department.
