Administrative Code: 7 AAC  
130.229(a)

In accordance with the authority of the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the correction to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. I have forwarded this correction under a specific delegation dated December 1, 2015 from the regulations attorney. This revision corrects a manifest error.

The regulation to be revised is 7 AAC 130.229(a). The revision to that subsection is as follows:

--Delete the material numbered as paragraph (3)

Also, after the end of 7 AAC 130.229, please insert an editor's note to read:

**Editor's note:** As of Register 227 (October 2018), the regulations attorney made a technical correction under AS 44.62.125(b)(6), to 7 AAC 130.229(a).

I compared what appears in print in the Alaska Administrative Code to what your office transmitted to the publisher--regulations filed October 6, 2017 and effective November 5, 2017--and I confirmed that a printing error occurred. As part of a reorganization of 7 AAC 130.229, the material previously set out as 7 AAC 130.229(a)(3) is now set out as 7 AAC 130.229(a)(2)(B); and text designated 7 AAC 130.229(a)(3) was not part of the transmittal. Therefore, what now appears in the Alaska Administrative Code as 7 AAC 130.229(a)(3) should be deleted.
