3 AAC 306.450; 3 AAC  
306.570(c)(4)(A) - (C)

In accordance with the authority of the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the corrections to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. I have forwarded these corrections under a specific delegation dated December 1, 2015 from the regulations attorney. These revisions correct manifest errors.

The regulations to be revised are 3 AAC 306.450 and 3 AAC 306.570(c)(4)(A) - (C).

The revision to 3 AAC 306.450 is as follows:

--Near the end of the introductory language of 3 AAC 306.450, change "marijuana cultivation family" to "marijuana cultivation facility"

The revisions to 3 AAC 306.570(c)(4)(A) - (C) are as follows:

--In 3 AAC 306.570(c)(4)(A), insert a period between the word "addictive" and the quotation mark.

--In 3 AAC 306.570(c)(4)(B), insert a period between the word "influence" and the quotation mark.

--In 3 AAC 306.570(c)(4)(C), insert a period between the word "marijuana" and the quotation mark.
