The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Marijuana Control Board against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. I have reviewed this project under a specific delegation dated August 7, 2018 from the regulations attorney. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems.

This memorandum constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. We note that the Marijuana Control Board has split this project into three parts, pending additional board work on proposed amendments to 3 AAC 306.720(e) and 3 AAC 306.990(b)(35). The regulations in Part 1 were adopted by the Marijuana Control Board after the close of the public comment period. The regulations concern the duration of marijuana handler permits and completion of marijuana handler permit education courses.

The April 22, 2018 public notice and the July 30, 2018 certification of adoption order both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.195 is not required.

The State of Alaska MARIJUANA Control Board proposes to adopt regulation changes in 3 AAC 306 of the Alaska Administrative Code, dealing with handler permits, video storage retention, and recreation and youth centers, including the following:

- 3 AAC 306.700(c) is proposed to change the date on which a marijuana handler permit is issued.
- 3 AAC 306.720(e) is proposed to extend the time in which surveillance recordings must be retained.
- 3 AAC 306.990 (b)(35) is proposed to add additional language defining a recreation or youth facility.
