NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES REGARDING WINE AUCTION PERMITS, SEASONAL LICENSES, OPERATING REQUIREMENTS, AND LOCAL GOVERNING BODY PROTESTS

The State of Alaska Alcoholic Beverage Control Board proposes to adopt regulation changes in 3 AAC 304 of the Alaska Administrative Code, dealing with wine auction permits, seasonal licenses, operating requirements, and local governing body protests, including the following:

- 3 AAC 304.145 is proposed to allow a local governing body with jurisdiction to protest a license application and to uphold a protest with a 180 day abeyance if the protest is subject to recision.
- 3 AAC 304.170 (h) is proposed to extend the deadline for waiver application to the last meeting of the calendar year.
- 3 AAC 304.170 (j) is amended to revise minimum operating requirement language.
- 3 AAC 304.170(k) is proposed to add new language requiring proof of minimum operating requirements.
- 3 AAC 304.190 is proposed new language regarding rights, privileges and restrictions for seasonal licenses.
- 3 AAC 304.699(a) is amended to clarify regulations for wine auction permits.
- 3 AAC 304.990 is amended to define "wine pull."

You may comment on the proposed regulation changes, including the potential costs to private persons of complying with the proposed changes, by submitting written comments to the Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office at 550 West 7th Avenue, Suite 1600, Anchorage, AK 99501. The comments must be received not later than 4:30 pm on October 10, 2018.

The questions must be received at least 10 days before the end of the public comment period. The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board will aggregate its response to substantially similar questions and make the questions and responses available on the Alaska Online Public Notice System and AMCO Website.
