ConocoPhillips Alaska, Inc. (CPAI) requests a new Land Administration System (LAS) 23296, which expires on September 30, 2018. The permit allows for temporary equipment and material storage on state land and used to support out of unit activities for Kuparuk River Unit (KRU).

CPAI is requesting for LAS 23296 to include activities on state land within the North Slope oil field KRU and Colville River Unit (CRU), as well as temporary equipment storage outside of the pipeline right-of-way in accordance with Alaska Statute (AS) 38.35 Pipeline Activities. CPAI request the permit be effective for five years beginning in 2018 through 2023. The current oneyear extension authorization includes only the KRU but had previously included the CRU.

Enclosed is a check in the amount of \$400 for the application fee. The annual user fee will be assessed at a later date.
