The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This memorandum constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations were adopted by the Department after the close of the public comment period and implement ch. 57, SLA 2018 provisions establishing business license endorsement for persons selling electronic smoking products or products containing nicotine. The adoption order identifies an effective date of January 1, 2019.

The August 28, 2018 public notice and the October 4, 2018 adoption order both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.195 is not required.
