In accordance with AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the corrections to the Alaska Administrative Code described below. These technical corrections correct manifest errors. The regulation to be revised is 8 AAC 61.140(b)(1) and (5), as filed September 20, 2018 (Department of Law file number 2018200517), with an effective date of October 20, 2018 and to appear in print Register 228 (January 2019).

Please reformat the text of 8 AAC 61.140(b)(1) as follows:

(1) for a willful or repeated violation under AS 18.60.095(a) may not exceed \$129,336; except that when a settlement is negotiated, the penalty for a willful violation may not be less than \$9,239;

Please reformat the text of 8 AAC 61.140(b)(5) as follows:

(5) for a posting violation under AS 18.60.095(g) is \$12,934.
