SUBJECT: Correction to the Alaska
Administrative Code (AAC):
3 AAC 26.665(b)(2)(E)

In accordance with the authority of the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the correction to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. I have forwarded this correction under a specific delegation dated December 1, 2015 from the regulations attorney. This revision corrects a manifest error.

The regulation to be revised is 3 AAC 26.665(b)(2)(E). The revision to that subparagraph is as follows:

--In the series of sub-subparagraphs, the last two are numbered (vii) and (ix), without a sub-subparagraph numbered (viii). To correct this break in sequence, please renumber "(ix)" as "(viii)".

In addition, at the end of the editor's note that follows 3 AAC 26.665, please add a new paragraph to read:

As of Register 228 (January 2019), the regulations attorney made a technical revision under AS 44.62.125(b)(6), to 3 AAC 26.665(b).

I compared how that provision appears in print in the Alaska Administrative Code, in the main pamphlet for April 216 (Register 221), with the text that the agency adopted for filing (Department of Law file number 993-03-0061), that took effect of January 1, 2005, and that has been unchanged since that date. I also examined the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC) model language that corresponds to 3 AAC 26.655(b)(2)(E) from that time. I have confirmed that the gap in the sub-subparagraph numbering in 3 AAC 26.655(b) is a manifest error.
