In accordance with the authority of the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the correction to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. I have forwarded this correction under a specific delegation dated December 1, 2015 from the regulations attorney. This revision corrects a manifest printing error.

The regulation to be revised is 4 AAC 12.310(d)(13). The revision to that paragraph is as follows:

--Change "before" to "on or after"

In addition, at the end of the editor's note that follows 4 AAC 12.310, please add a new paragraph to read:

As of Register 228 (January 2019), the regulations attorney made a technical revision under AS 44.62.125(b)(6), to 4 AAC 12.310(d).

I compared how that provision appears in print in the October 2018 quarterly supplement (Register 227) with the text as filed on May 2, 2018 with an effective date of June 1, 2018 and as transmitted to the publisher. I have confirmed that the use of "before" rather than "on or after" in 4 AAC 12.310(d)(13) is a publisher's error.
