I have forwarded these corrections under a specific delegation dated December 1, 2015 from the regulations attorney. These revisions correct manifest errors.

The regulations to be revised are two provisions of 12 AAC 79, regulations of the Board of Massage Therapists. The revisions to those provisions are as follows:

**In 12 AAC 79.210(h):**
