I have forwarded this change under a specific delegation dated December 1, 2015 from the regulations attorney. The purpose of the change is to identify an amended version of material previously adopted by reference.

Dear Shellfish Harvesters and Dealers-

FDA has announced the publication of the new NSSP Model Ordinance (MO), Guide for the Control of Molluscan Shellfish. You may find the MO at the following FDA website link:

https://www.fda.gov/downloads/Food/GuidanceRegulation/FederalStateFoodPrograms/UCM623551.pdf . The NSSP-MO is now in full effect and, as of November 15, 2018, all permitted shellfish firms will be inspected according to the requirements of the NSSP MO.

Alaska law allows DEC to automatically adopt by reference the NSSP MO. Though we have sent out less formal emails announcing the new requirements that will be set out in this 2017 version, this email serves as a more official notification of our adoption of the NSSP MO. This means that DEC enforces the requirements found in the NSSP MO. Attached is a copy of the legal notice describing DEC's intentions to adopt the newest version.

SIGNIFICANT CHANGES

Below is a summary of a couple of significant changes:

Shellfish Tags

A new requirement to change the language on shellfish tags will go into effect on January 1, 2019.

A Few Reminders

- Now is a good time to review your HACCP plans to make sure they are still effective and make sure you sign off to indicate you've done your annual review!
- If you are a dealer who ships to another dealer, make sure you're complying with Transportation Documentation requirements.
- If you are a dealer who receives shellstock from another dealer, make sure you've included at the Receiving critical control point (CCP) a critical limit (CL) that you monitor the shipment to make sure that <u>transportation documentation</u> (shipment time/temp) is complete! (see Chapter IX.04 & .05 as well as Chapter XIII.01.A(2)(b))
- If you are confused about HACCP requirements (including what CCPs you should include, what CL is appropriate, or what monitoring you should be doing, please reach out to us and we can help you sort through the requirements!
- Remember to include actual values on your monitoring forms. For example, if you take a temperature or calibrate your thermometer, make sure you record "0" F" not just a check mark that you completed the task. If you record the concentration of a chlorine hand dip, make sure that you note the PPM, not just a check mark that you completed the check.
- Remember to review the monitoring records each week and note that you've looked them over!

"Thoroughly cooking foods of animal origin such as shellfish reduces the risk of foodborne illness. Individuals with certain health conditions such as liver disease, chronic alcohol abuse, diabetes, cancer, stomach, blood or immune disorders may be at higher risk if these foods are consumed raw or undercooked. Consult your physician or public health official for further information."



The addition of the new language is meant to reinforce shellfish tag retention requirements to retailers. If you are interested in emphasizing retention requirements to dealers, I have attached a fact sheet that discusses requirements. Though you are not required, you are welcomed to print and hand this out to your retailers. On the retail/food service side of the house, we often find that retailers/food service operators are confused about how to keep tags and the reason for the requirements. As some of you have experienced, this information is critical to accurately tracing the source when there is a report of illness associated with consumption of molluscan shellfish.


As a reminder, all shellfish tags must be durable, waterproof, and approved by DEC prior to use.

Safe Shellfish Handling Training for Employees

In addition to the tag change, dealers will be required to train all employees on safe food handling (e.g., temperature control, employee health & hygiene, cleaning & sanitizing – basically, the things in your sanitation procedures). Dealers are only required to train the employee one time, but you must keep a record indicating when each employee is trained.

The training curriculum is up to the dealer and it is best if the training is relevant and specific to each person's duties, as well as the location and operation. If you are interested, there is general food safety training (not specifically targeted for shellfish safety, but most of the same general principles apply) on our program website HERE. You may find it easier to utilize the Shellfish Dealer Training that is available online HERE under General Requirements. As well, we have free posters and stickers that you may print off HERE. I am also happy to share a PowerPoint presentation that I shared at an ASGA meeting a few years ago. Just send me an email if you'd like me to send it.
