The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Department of Natural Resources against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This memorandum constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations were adopted by the Department of Natural Resources after the close of the public comment period. The regulations concern general land use activity, making an amendment to 11 AAC 96.020, generally allowed uses of state land, for activities not conducted for a commercial recreational purpose.

The proposed regulation changes were published in the Anchorage Daily News and Fairbanks Daily News-Miner, and distributed as required under AS 44.62.190. The January 25, 2019 public notice and the March 7, 2019 adoption order both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.195 is not required.

Dear Alaskan:

The Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is proposing to revise 11 AAC 96.020(a)(5)(A) to correct an error made in its previous revision of this regulation as part of its July 1, 2018 fee regulation revision. At that time DNR erroneously removed the word "recreational" from that regulation and added other conditional language. This proposed revision would reverse that change, replace the word "recreational" in that regulation, and remove the added conditional language. I am writing to explain the proposed regulation amendment, why we are proposing this regulation package now and how this action relates to the ongoing resource management process. I invite you to review and comment on these proposed regulations.

Why Do We Need These Regulations Now?

In 2018, DNR revised 11 AAC 96.020(a)(5)(A) as part of its overall fee regulations effort. The amendment to remove the word "recreational" from that regulation and added other conditional language was intended to ensure that any commercial use in excess of generally allowed uses listed in that section or 11 AAC 96.010, required a land use permit. However, as it currently reads, 11 AAC 96.020(a)(5)(A) now actually requires that ANY commercial use, no matter how small or incidental may require a land use permit. For example, a land surveyor or appraiser who simply wants to walk across state land to access a private property to perform a survey or appraisal would be required to obtain a land use permit from DNR. This is not consistent with the department's intent for that amendment of for generally allowed uses of state public domain lands. DNR is proposing to return the wording of this regulation as it read since 2000, and before the summer field season in 2019.

Opportunity for Comment.



The Department of Natural Resources proposes to adopt regulation changes in Title 11 of the Alaska Administrative Code, dealing with generally allowed uses of state public domain land. Specifically, the Department of Natural Resources is proposing to amend 11 AAC 05.020(a)(5)(A) regarding commercial recreational land use.
