The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Marijuana Control Board against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This memorandum constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations were adopted by the Marijuana Control Board after the close of the public comment period. The regulations adjust the requirement that applicants for new marijuana establishment licenses or transfers submit fingerprints and fees for a criminal background check. so that the requirement includes applicants for ownership changes. The regulations also provide that an individual who has already submitted fingerprints and fees with an initial application need not submit them again for a second or subsequent application for a new license, transfer, or ownership change, if the second or subsequent application is submitted not later than 12 calendar months after the date of receipt of criminal justice information in response to the initial submission of fingerprints and fees.

The January 3, 2019 public notice and the March 14, 2019 certification of adoption order both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.195 is not required.
