The Department of Law has reviewed the attached non-Administrative Procedure Act (non-APA) regulations of the Department of Administration. The regulations establish additional periodic payment distribution options under the defined contribution plans for the Public Employees' Retirement System and Teachers' Retirement System.

Because these regulations are not subject to AS 44.62 (Administrative Procedure Act), the Department of Law reviews them only for printing in the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC). We have edited the regulations for style in order to forward them for printing in the AAC, and corrected manifest clerical errors.

Please note that under AS 14.25.005(g) and AS 39.35.005(g) the regulation changes take effect April 28, 2019, 30 days after adoption by the commissioner of administration.

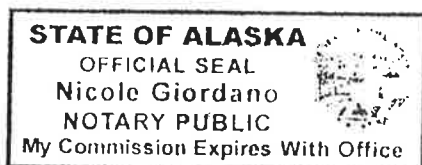

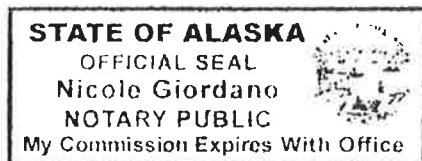

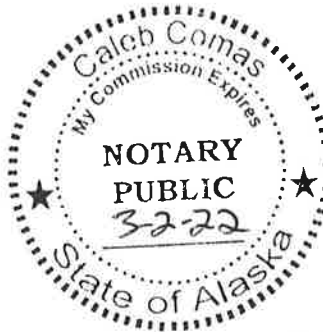
