Currently in RFP

Section 1.04 Minimum Qualifications Company:

Page 5 Paragraph 3 Sections A and C

- A. Quality and experience of the security guard and the service provided will be a critical element of the contract. All security guards must have a minimum 5 years prior state or large municipality law enforcement experience, which must be between the years 2019 – 2009.
- C. Due to a potential conflict of interest Guards may not have a personal history of working directly or indirectly with OCS staff and offices within the last (10) years.

Change to the Following:

- A. Quality and experience of the security guard and the service provided will be a critical element of the contract. Security guard must have a minimum 5 years prior state, large municipality law enforcement or military security forces experience which must be between the years 2019-2009. Up to 2 years of armed security guard experience may be substituted for up to 2 years of state, large municipality law enforcement or military security forces experience.
