This amendment serves to clarify and amend the following:

Currently in RFP and/or Amendment 1

Section 1.04 Minimum Qualifications Company:

Page 5 Paragraph 3 Section A

- A. Quality and experience of the security guard and the service provided will be a critical element of the contract. Security guard must have a minimum 5 years prior state, large municipality law enforcement or military security forces experience which must be between the years 2019-2009. Up to 2 years of armed security guard experience may be substituted for up to 2 years of state, large municipality law enforcement or military security forces experience

Change to the Following:

- A. Quality and experience of the security guard and the service provided will be a critical element of the contract. Security guard must have a minimum 5 years prior state, large municipality law enforcement or military security forces experience which must be between the years 2019-2009. Up to 2 years of armed security guard experience may be substituted for up to 2 years of state, large municipality law enforcement or military security forces experience. Armed Guards that are currently performing duties resulting from current OCS contracts may use that experience to meet the 5 year minimum experience.

REMOVE THE FOLLOWING TWO SENTENCES FOR ALL 5 LOCATIONS

Additionally after hours guard service may be required as requested by the OCS POC. Services shall be billed at an hourly rate.

Section 3.01 Proposal Format and Content

Page 20, Paragraph 2

Proposals will be limited to a total of no more than 25 pages (with no smaller than 11 pt font), including attachments such as resumes of project staff. The Cost Proposal will not be included in the page limit.

Change to the Following:

Proposals will be limited to a total of no more than 50 pages (with no smaller than 11 pt font), including attachments such as resumes of project staff. The Cost Proposal will not be included in the page limit.

CLARIFICATION

Question:

Are officers required to remain on location during the Lunch Break? If so, and for the cost proposal calculation, will OCS pay officers for the Lunch Break period?

Answer:

An officer must be present during the hours of operation (page 12 and 13 under LOCATION, paragraph A) including morning and afternoon break as well as lunch. It is the contractor's discretion if breaks are paid, all expenses should be included in the cost proposal
