## NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES IN THE REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES

## **BRIEF DESCRIPTION**

The Department of Natural Resources proposes to change regulations dealing with using or discharging firearms in a small portion of the Hatcher Pass Special Use Area, to allow for a possible biathlon range.

The Department of Natural Resources proposes to adopt regulation changes in Title 11 of the Alaska Administrative Code, dealing with using or discharging firearms in a small portion of the Hatcher Pass Special Use Area.

Specifically, 11 AAC 96.014(b)(3)(E) is proposed to be amended to allow the use or discharge of firearms in a possible biathlon range within a portion of the Southern Development Area of the Government Peak Unit of the Hatcher Pass Management Plan as depicted on the map entitled Hatcher Pass Management Plan, Government Peak Unit, Southern Development Area, Biathlon Range Area.
