For the purpose of "Complete Delivery", how do you define "Origin"? This gets very complicated and we need clarification.

Answer#1:

Origin is defined as the point or place where something begins, arises, or is derived.
For the purposes if this ITB Origin means the location (manufacturer, or bulk storage facility) where the product is loaded in the ISOs for final delivery.

Question #2

Would you "PLEASE" confirm with your Operations Manager(s) at these locations? IF they are OK with 4" or do have to be 3" Camlock Fittings? I am being told that I have to get some kind of "Waiver" for this???

Answer #2:

Per page 15 of the ITB DELIVERY REQUIREMENTS item #1:

1. The DOT/PF storage tanks are fitted with a 3" Cam-Lock fitting. Pumps will be provided by DOT&PF.

Question #3:

Is 4" OK? If not, I have a 4" Female to 3" Male Crossover which should work.

Answer#3:

Please see the answer #2 above.

Question #4:

Pumps will be provided by DOT&PF.....So is DOT&PF Providing the hoses from ISO Tank to pump and from pump to DOT&PF Storage Tank(s)?

Answer #4:

The State will provide the pump and pump hoses.
