The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Department of Natural Resources against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This memorandum constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations were adopted by the Department after the close of the public comment period. The regulations concern Glacier/Winner Creek special use area. Under current regulation, only one commercial snowcat operator may obtain a permit to operate in the area. The regulation change would allow more than one commercial snowcat operator to receive a permit to operate. The department would like this regulation to be in effect by January 1, 2020, to allow for operation during the 2020 ski season.

The generally allowed uses listed in 11 AAC 96.020 would continue to apply to the area, as would the registration requirements for certain uses identified in 11 AAC 96.018, including for commercial recreation activities. The Glacier Creek and Winner Creek drainages are closed to mineral entry pursuant to administrative and legislative closures. Mineral Order (Closing) 1121; ch. 26, SLA 2012 (an act closing certain land within Glacier Creek and Winner Creek to new mineral entry). The mineral closures prevent mineral entry (i.e., the acquisition of new property rights in minerals), but do not affect recreational gold panning, prospecting, or suction dredging allowed under 11 AAC 96.020(a)(3)(E)-(G). The area was closed to mineral entry because the Glacier and Winner Creek drainages contain significant commercial recreation infrastructure and possess strong potential for future recreational development. Mineral entry and development would therefore be incompatible with existing and planned future uses of the area.
