The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Department of Natural Resources against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This memorandum constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulation establishes a limited use exception in the Government Peak Unit of the Hatcher Pass Management Plan to allow use of an approved firearm in a biathlon range approved by the Matanuska-Susitna Borough.

The regulations were adopted by the department after the close of the public comment period. The public notice and the adoption order both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.195 is not required.

We have made some technical corrections to conform the regulations in accordance with AS 44.62.125. The corrections are shown on the attached copy of the regulations.


