Register 233, April 2020 PROFESSIONAL REGULATIONS

Chapter 02. General Occupational Licensing Functions.

12 AAC 02.215 is amended to read:

12 AAC 02.215. Euthanasia of domestic animals. The following fees are established for agencies that purchase, possess, and use certain drugs to euthanize domestic animals:

- (1) **nonrefundable** application fee for initial euthanasia permit, **\$100** [\$25];
- (2) permit fee for all or part of the initial biennial license period, \$300 [\$25];
- (3) biennial permit renewal fee, \$300 [\$25]. (Eff. 11/15/2002, Register 164; am 6/17/2005, Register 174; am 6/9/2007, Register 182; am 6/28/2009, Register 190; am 5/15/2013,

Register 206; am 3 / 5 / 2020, Register 233)
