Addendum One provides answers to questions received from vendors. This Addendum One is hereby made part of the RFP and is a total of 3 pages.

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Question 1: Will survey services be awarded for projects that just require platting and other surveys or will those services be awarded under the Survey Services RFP 10 200000055?

Answer: No. Survey work may or may not be related to construction projects/construction management. The Trust Land Office may award projects that require purely survey work. RFP 10-002-20 is a broader scope to include construction projects and management; however the Trust Land Office may award survey-only work through either this RFP or RFP 10 200000055 1.

Question 2: Is it the intent of the DNR to now have an on-call surveying services roster, or has this particular contract issue in the past and perhaps we just missed the posting?

Answer: The Trust Land Office has historically worked survey projects through the use of term contracts such as these. They are not project specific, nor is there a guarantee of any level of work; however, working with vendors under a term contract allows the Trust Land Office to move quickly when work is needed.

Question 3: What is the intent behind this RFP, since you just advertised the A/E contract, which also includes survey. Are you anticipating an increased need for these services?

Answer: We anticipate a continued need for survey services and are seeking the flexibility and responsiveness that a 2nd contract would afford us. More specifically, the survey work that would fall under this RFP 200000055 1 is likely to be smaller in scale/scope than the work requested under the Engineering contract.

Question 4: Section 1.04 Prior Experience, it is required to have experience locating primary/secondary US Survey monuments. Does this mean *specifically* US Surveys (i.e. US Survey 1234, Alaska), or is it intended to mean Public Land Survey monuments?

Answer: It is intended to mean Public Land Survey monuments, i.e. Federal Survey monuments.
