8 AAC 45.186(c) and (e)

In accordance with the authority of the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the corrections to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. I have forwarded these corrections under a specific delegation dated December 3, 2018 from the regulations attorney. These revisions correct manifest errors in references to laws.

The regulations to be revised are 8 AAC 45.186(c) and (e). The revisions to those subsections are as follows:

--In 8 AAC 45.186(c), change "AS 23.30.205(f)(1)" to
"AS 23.30.205(g)(1)"

--In 8 AAC 45.186(e), at both appearances, change
"AS 23.30.205(f)(2)" to "AS 23.30.205(g)(2)"

In addition, following 8 AAC 45.186, please insert an editor's note to read as follows:

Editor's note: In 2018 the revisor of statutes, acting under AS 01.05.031, re-lettered former AS 23.30.205(f) as AS 23.30.205(g). As of Register 231 (April 2020), the regulations attorney made conforming technical revisions under AS 44.62.125(b)(6), to 8 AAC 45.186(c) and (e), so that cross-references to former AS 23.30.205(f)(1) and (2) now refer to the re-lettered statute, AS 23.30.205(g)(1) and (2).
