Administrative Code (AAC):
12 AAC 09.173

In accordance with the authority of the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher this correction to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC). I have forwarded this correction under a delegation dated December 3, 2018 from the Regulations Attorney. The correction resolves a manifest error in a history note.

Please revise the history note of 12 AAC 09.173 as follows:

--Delete the current note and insert the following corrected language: "Eff. 5/26/2004, Register 170; am 4/5/2018, Register 226; am 3/30/2019, Register 229"

--In addition, please add a new editor's note following 12 AAC 09.173 to read:

Editor's note: As of Register 233 (April 2020), and acting under the authority of AS 44.62.125(b)(6), the regulations attorney made a technical revision to the history note of 12 AAC 09.173.

Review of previous publications of the Alaska Administrative Code confirms that 12 AAC 09.173 did not appear in print until Register 170. The agency's online publication relating to the adoption of 12 AAC 09.173 and agency staff further confirm that the provision took effect May 26, 2004 (Register 170). The above revision corrects this apparent error in the current history note.
