
The restrictive nature of this regulation could negatively impact the health of the public by decreasing healthcare worker availability during this public health emergency cause by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Register 234, July 2020 PROFESSIONAL REGULATIONS

Chapter 44. Board of Nursing.

12 AAC 44.815(a) is amended to read:

(a) An initial nurse aide certification is valid for the remainder of the current biennial certification period. A nurse aide certification must be renewed biennially on or before **a date set by the department** [MARCH 31 OF EVEN-NUMBERED YEARS]. A renewal reminder will be mailed to each currently certified nurse aide at least 60 days before the renewal date. A certification that is not renewed lapses.


On a motion to adjourn made by Wendy Monrad and seconded by Catherine Hample and rejected with 4 nays the Board of Nursing did not adjourn.
