Title 5. Fish and Game.**Part 5. Protection of Fish and Game Habitat.****Chapter 95. Fish and Game Habitat.****Article 1. Fish Habitat.**

5 AAC 95.011(a) is amended to read:

(a) The *Atlas to the Catalog of Waters Important for Spawning, Rearing, or Migration of Anadromous Fishes*, and the *Catalog of Waters Important for Spawning, Rearing, or Migration of Anadromous Fishes*, as revised as of March 2020 [2019], are adopted by reference. The six volume atlas is a compilation of topographic maps upon which are specified, as provided in AS 16.05.871(a), the various rivers, lakes, or streams, or parts of them, that are important for the spawning, rearing, or migration of anadromous fish. The catalog is a listing of those water bodies. It sets out legal descriptions for the mouth and the known upper range of the fish of each stream, river, or lake designated on the maps in the atlas. The atlas and the catalog identify the water bodies for which a person or agency must first notify the department, as required by AS 16.05.871(b), before undertaking to construct a hydraulic project, or to use, divert, obstruct, pollute, or change the natural flow or bed of a specified river, lake, or stream, or to use wheeled, tracked, or excavating equipment or log-dragging equipment in the bed of a specified river, lake, or stream.

As of Register 166 (July 2003), and acting under AS 44.62.125(b)(6), until Register 186 (July 2008), the regulations attorney relocated former 5 AAC 95.010 to 11 AAC 195.010, and made conforming technical changes, to reflect Executive Order 107 (2003). Executive Order 107 transferred functions related to protection of fish habitat in rivers, lakes, and streams from the Department of Fish and Game to the Department of Natural Resources.

As of Register 186 (July 2008), and acting under AS 44.62.125(b)(6), the regulations attorney relocated former 11 AAC 195.010 to 5 AAC 95.011, and made conforming technical changes, to reflect Executive Order 114 (2008). Executive Order 114 transferred functions related to protection of fish habitat in rivers, lakes, and streams from the Department of Natural Resources to the Department of Fish and Game. The history note for 5 AAC 95.011 carries forward the history from former 5 AAC 95.010 and former 11 AAC 195.010.

The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Department of Fish and Game against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This memorandum constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The department, in its April 27, 2020 submission of the adopted regulations to the Department of Law, *requests a June 1, 2020 effective date.*

The regulations were adopted by the department after the close of the public comment period. The regulations concern the yearly updating of the catalogs important to the health and lifecycle of anadromous fishes.

The adoption order states that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.195 is not required.

The Department of Fish and Game will submit the updated catalogs to your office.

We have made a technical correction to conform the regulations in accordance with AS 44.62.125. The correction is shown on the attached copy of the regulations.

NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES ON SPECIFIED ANADROMOUS WATERS
IN THE REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME

BRIEF DESCRIPTION

The Alaska Department of Fish and Game proposes to change regulations dealing with waters important for the spawning, rearing, or migration of anadromous fish, as required by AS 16.05.871.

The Alaska Department of Fish and Game proposes to adopt regulation changes in Title 5 of the Alaska Administrative Code, dealing with waters important for the spawning, rearing, or migration of anadromous fish, including the following:

5 AAC 95.011 is proposed to be changed as follows:

The Atlas to the Catalog of Waters Important for the Spawning, Rearing, or Migration of Anadromous Fishes and *Catalog of Waters Important for the Spawning, Rearing, or Migration of Anadromous Fishes* (atlas and catalog), which are adopted by reference in 5 AAC 95.011, will be revised and updated.

Several revisions are proposed to be made to the atlas and catalog. The list of rivers, lakes, and streams will be updated, including additions, deletions, and changes to the legal descriptions of many of these waters. Minor revisions will be made to the introduction of the catalog. Species-specific information will be used in place of undifferentiated species information wherever possible.

You may comment on the proposed regulation changes, including the potential costs to private persons of complying with the proposed changes, by submitting written comments to Brian Blossom, Alaska Department of Fish and Game, River Center 514 Funny River Road, Soldotna, AK 99669. Additionally, the Alaska Department of Fish and Game will accept comments by facsimile at (907) 260-5992 or by e-mail to dfg.hab.anadromous@alaska.gov. The comments must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. AKST, March 20, 2020.

You may submit written questions relevant to the proposed action to Brian Blossom by email or at the physical address above. The questions must be received at least 10 days before the end of the public comment period. The Alaska Department of Fish and Game will aggregate its response to substantially similar questions and make the questions and responses available on <http://awc.adfg.alaska.gov>. The Alaska Department of Fish and Game may, but is not required to, answer written questions received after the 10-day cut-off date and before the end of the comment period.
