FINDING OF EMERGENCY

The Board of Professional Counselors finds that an emergency exists and that the attached regulation changes are necessary to 12 AAC 62.400, dealing with distance professional services, for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, or general welfare. Register 234, July 2020 PROFESSIONAL REGULATIONS

Chapter 62. Board of Professional Counselors.

12 AAC 62.400(b)(2) is amended to read:

(2) have completed a minimum of six continuing education hours from a <u>board</u> [NATIONAL BOARD FOR CERTIFIED COUNSELORS (NBCC)] approved continuing education provider <u>under 12 AAC 62.320(b)(2)</u> pertaining to distance professional services; and

12 AAC 62.400(d) is amended to read:

(d) <u>Except as provided in (h) of this section, an</u> [AN] individual located in this state must be licensed under AS 08.29 before providing distance professional counseling service, regardless of the location of the client receiving the service.

12 AAC 62.400 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(h) During an emergency disaster declared by the governor under AS 26.23.020, an applicant working under a board approved supervisor under 12 AAC 62.200 may provide distance professional counseling service in accordance with this section during the declared emergency. The applicant working under a supervisor must meet with the supervisor synchronously at least biweekly, preferably weekly. (Eff. 11/10/2019, Register 232; am
