The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This memorandum constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations were adopted by the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities after the close of the public comment period. The regulations modify the fee structure for department services provided to rural airports after work hours.

The November 11, 2018, public notice and the March 3, 2020, adoption order both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.195 is not required.
