Corrections

Questions and Answers

Question 1: What is the expected timeline of procurement aside from the projected January 2021 start date?

Answer: The state anticipates a five-year plan to fully implement the new system. Vendors should include in their responses how long they think the project will take, as well as provide milestones for payment.

Question 2: Has funding been approved for this? If so, through what means?

Answer: The state has received initial funding to start the project through an NCHIP grant; the state anticipates continuing to request NCHIP and/or NARIP funds to complete the project in conjunction with state matching funds and potentially a capital funds request.

Question 3: Is there a cost estimate you would be able to provide for this project?

Answer: No. Vendor cost estimates should be included in responses.

Question 4: The hard-copy responses, this RFI is a short response window which is no problem you will definitely get the electronic response but my concern is the hard-copies may be delayed due to the COVID issues delaying shipping. My question is are the hard-copies mandatory and if so will they be accepted if they are possibly delayed getting to you (again you will have our electronic response on time)
