The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Real Estate Commission against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This memorandum constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations were adopted by the Real Estate Commission after the close of the public comment period. The regulations remove a notarization requirement for real estate salesperson (the applicant must still certify the information on the form is true and correct to the best of the applicant's knowledge) and associate broker license applications and clarification that the expiry date for initial approvals granted to real estate educational course instructors runs through April 1 (rather than March 31).

The May 13, 2020 public notice and the June 17, 2020 certification of adoption order both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.195 is not required. We did not make any edits to the regulations.


