The attached eighteen pages of regulations, dealing with practical examinations, application requirements, and a proficiency examination, are hereby certified to be a correct copy of the regulation changes that the Board of Barbers and Hairdressers adopted at its October 5-6, 2020 videoconference meeting, under the authority of AS 08.01.062; AS 08.13.030; AS 08.13.040; AS 08.13.070; AS 08.13.080; AS 08.13.082; AS 08.13.090; AS 08.13.100; AS 08.13.110; AS 08.13.120; AS 08.13.140; AS 08.13.180; and AS 08.13.220, and after compliance with the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62), specifically including notice under AS 44.62.190 and 44.62.200 and opportunity for public comment under AS 44.62.210.

This action is not expected to require an increased appropriation.

On the record, in considering public comments, the Board of Barbers and Hairdressers paid special attention to the cost to private persons of the regulatory action being taken.
