The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Board of Dental Examiners against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This memorandum constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations were adopted by the Board of Dental Examiners after the close of the public comment period.

The regulations update requirements for examinations for dental hygienists, particularly clinical examinations. The regulations include an amendment to 12 AAC 28.320(a)(4) that the Board of Dental Examiners made after public notice; the amendment, similar to the amendment that the board already proposed for 12 AAC 28.935(b)(7), clarifies that an applicant may take an equivalent to the Western Regional Examining Board (WREB) examination.

The September 4, 2020 public notice and the October 16, 2020 certification of adoption order both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.195 is not required.

We have made some technical corrections to conform the regulations in accordance with AS 44.62.125. The corrections are shown on the attached copy of the regulations.
