SUBJECT: Corrections to the Alaska  
Administrative Code (AAC):  
4 AAC 06.737

In accordance with the authority of the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the corrections to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. I have forwarded these corrections under a specific delegation dated March 23, 2020 from the regulations attorney. These revisions correct a manifest printing error.

The regulation to be revised is 4 AAC 06.737. This section presently should be a stand-alone section, not split into subsections, paragraphs, or smaller subdivisions. But starting with Register 228 (January 2019), the text is displayed incorrectly as three numbered paragraphs, without introductory language. What is displayed as “(1)” is what ought to be the single stand-alone section; what is displayed as “(2)” and “(3)” largely repeat what is set out as “(1)”.

Please request that the publisher delete the incorrect display of 4 AAC 06.737, so that what is displayed as “(1)” is restored to a stand-alone section and the text in “(2)” and “(3)” is deleted.

Also, please request that the publisher prepare an errata sheet.
