In accordance with the authority of the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the correction to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. I have forwarded this correction under a specific delegation dated March 23, 2020 from the regulations attorney. This revision corrects a manifest error in the placement of two sections in the Alaska Administrative Code.

The regulations in the wrong spot are 3 AAC 304.920 and 3 AAC 304.925. Presently, they are out of numerical order and assigned to the wrong article: they incorrectly follow 3 AAC 304.225 and are incorrectly assigned to Article 2 (licensing). Please request that, as part of Register 236 (January 2021), the publisher move 3 AAC 304.920 and 3 AAC 304.925 to their correct location: after 3 AAC 304.910, in Article 8 (general provisions).
